The Stadtcasino is a new building, a remodeled building, and a renovated building all in one. The Stehlin Musiksaal of 1876 is famous for its extraordinary acoustics and is the best concert hall for a discerning listening experience—not only in Switzerland but far beyond! The hall has now been complemented by foyers and staircases as well as unusual sequences of spaces and combinations for the enjoyment of visitors throughout the building.

We wanted to bring together neo-Baroque, classicist and contemporary elements to create a new type of architecture that can exist only in Basel, in this location so rich in tradition and yet so contemporary. Actually, this is more than a new building; it is a new place: the Stadtcasino no longer consists only of the familiar façade facing Steinenberg; the carriage lane establishes a connection with Barfüsserplatz, and the concert hall has become a stand-alone palazzo of music next to the Barfüsserkirche.

With the extension of the Stadtcasino Basel, an independent palazzo will be created in the urban unit, which will decisively strengthen the traditional Basel cultural mile.
